We want to share important news regarding the ongoing legal case affecting your FEA.

Preliminary Injunction Update

The Court has ruled in FEA's favor, denying the government's motion and dissolving the Administrative Stay it had initially ordered. This means FEA's rights are restored as they were when Judge Friedman issued his original order.

With this decision, FEA leaders will soon have their official time reinstated, and FEA will once again be able to fully carry out its representation duties and exercise all rights, including filing grievances. We expect DoDEA to comply with the Court's order, even though the timeline for this restoration is unclear.

For now, FEA is moving forward with the understanding that our rights are fully restored, and we are prepared to respond to developments as they unfold.
