This is the result of years of collaboration between FEA and NEA reflecting the determination and persistence of FEA leaders and members advocating for fair reassignment opportunities across the DoDEA schools.

The new agreement ensures a more transparent, consistent, and equitable reassignment process for all DoDEA educators. It represents a significant step forward in protecting members' rights and strengthening fairness within the system.
