



0336 Teacher, Health Care

- A state OR DoDEA professional teacher certificate in any secondary area AND a current valid clinical health care certificate. (Examples of health care certificate programs, but are not limited to, include the following: nurse (LPN or RN), nurse technician, nursing assistant, EKG technician, medical assistant, dental assistant, mental health clinician, and physical therapist.)

0386 Training Instructor (Health Care)

- Graduation from a U.S. accredited institution with an associate or higher level degree in nursing AND a current and valid license as a Registered Nurse AND 2 1/2 years of experience at the level that demonstrates instruction or supervision of employees in a health care field. Up to 1 1/2 years of the required 2 1/2 years of experience may be substituted by education at the rate of 1 year of study for 9 months of experience in the subject specialty for which applying.
