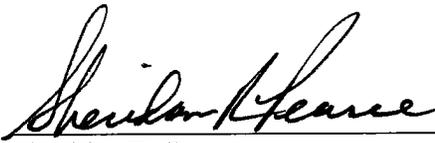
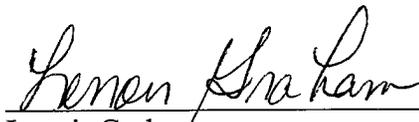


MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Topic:

READ 180-Enterprise-Stage A, Scholastic Reading Inventory, and Reading Counts for the Pacific

Background:

Large elementary schools experienced difficulties with concurrent usage of Scholastic's READ 180, SRI, and RC products. READ 180-Enterprise Stage A was piloted for thirty days in one large elementary school in the Pacific, as a solution to the concurrency issue.

Current Status:

- Stearley Heights ES has completed their thirty day pilot of Enterprise; the DoDDS-P Area Office and personnel from school sites conducted a fifteen and thirty day written evaluation of the program. Evaluations indicated the concurrency issue has improved with the installation of Enterprise.
- As a result of the pilot evaluations, during SY 07/08 READ 180-Enterprise Edition, Stage A implementation is projected for those elementary schools in the Pacific housing only one stage of READ 180 on its servers.

Process for Implementation

- March/April 2007: Technology Audits to be completed by elementary schools in DoDDS-Pacific.
- July/August: READ 180 Enterprise materials will be shipped to elementary schools in DoDDS-Pacific.
- August/September 2007: Two-day READ 180-Enterprise Stage A Training conducted in DoDDS-Pacific; Educational Technologists will receive one day of training by attending the second day of training for READ 180-Enterprise, Stage A teachers. Selected Information Technologists and Administrative Technologists in DoDDS-Pacific will receive training from the Pacific Area Office.
 - DoDDS-Pacific Dates
 - 10-11 September: Two-Two Day Teacher Training
 - 12-13 September: Two-Two Day Teacher Training
- Professional Development shall be comprised of three stages:

Stage One: To ensure the successful implementation of the technology component of READ 180-Enterprise, Stage A, selected ITs and ATs shall receive training from the Pacific Area Office. In addition, the Contractor shall develop a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for ITs and ATs. This document shall be updated on a regular basis and posted on the DoDEA-READ 180 Webpage.

Stage Two: READ 180 Enterprise Edition, Stage A training shall consist of two days; ETs shall receive one day of training by attending the second day of training for teachers. The agenda for the first day shall consist of reviewing the DoDEA Grades 3-6 ELA standards; learning about the Enterprise Edition of READ 180 and the accompanying materials. The second day of training shall consist of practicing using Scholastic Achievement Manager. In addition, READ 180 Enterprise Edition, Stage

A teachers will continue to have the opportunity to take Scholastic Red's READ 180 Enterprise Edition online professional development course.

Stage Three: A one-hour PowerPoint presentation detailing the differences between using Scholastic Reading Inventory and Reading Counts in READ 180 and READ 180 Enterprise shall be available for teachers. The presentation shall include directions on using Scholastic Achievement Manager. Each Area and/or school will determine how the PowerPoint presentation will be used to train general education teachers.
