

Issue: Rollout of Autodesk Upgrade

Background: The DoDEA Career and Technical Education (CTE formerly PTS) curriculum for technology and engineering has a requirement to continue providing high school students (grades 9-12) with up-to-date software resources and curriculum materials which meet industry standards. DoDEA's CTE technology and engineering courses must provide students with the opportunity to learn the essential skills necessary to transition from school to industry.

DoDEA has been using Autodesk products since 1996 and has invested substantial funds in products, teacher training, and curriculum materials that meet its CTE curriculum content standards for technology and engineering. The following schools are planning to offer classes using Autodesk products in SY 2015-2016.

Current Status:

In order to comply with license requirements and to ensure students and teachers are using the most current version of the software, all versions of Autodesk prior to 2012 will be removed during summer 2015. All teachers and students will be expected to use Autodesk 2015 products beginning fall 2015.

Next Step:

Autodesk and Computer Animations teachers will be provided 1 day of release time from students with substitute coverage at the beginning of SY 2015-2016 for personal orientation of the update including online videos and live support from CTE-HQ Coordinator. This training must be completed by September 30, 2015.
