

Educational Technologist Certification

A major in Instructional Technology or a minimum of 18 semester hours of instructional technology-related course work is required.

The 18 semester hours are divided into two general categories – instructional courses and technology courses.

Instructional courses must be distributed in at least three of the following instructional areas: instructional design, distance education, integration of technology into curriculum, planning for technology, assessment of technology, technology and special needs, and staff development.

Technology courses must be distributed in at least three of the following technology areas: web and/or graphics design, contemporary programming languages, multimedia, digital video, internet in classroom, databases, and local and/or wide area networks in instructional settings.
