

Memorandum of Understanding**


Using Data to Differentiate Instruction

The Department of Defense Education Activity (DODEA) and the Federal Education Association (FEA), hereafter referred to as the "parties," hereby agree to the following concerning the implementation of Using Data to Differentiate Instruction (UDDI).


- a. Beginning SY 2010/11, the awareness year, the parties agree to train on UDDI.
- b. Module II and Module III will be delivered to all educators in an uninterrupted 1/2 day release time during SY 2010/11.
- c. Once Module II and III are completed, all educators will be provided a 1/2 day release time during the second semester SY 2010/11 to collaborate with principals and other educators in their curricular area on how to integrate UDDI into the curriculum.
- d. The parties agree to develop virtual training on UDDI Modules I, II and III as an orientation for new educators.
- e. The parties agree that teachers and administrators will be given time to study data, individually and collectively, and to collaborate about best practices for UDDI.
- f. The parties agree to form a group to outline further implementation for UDDI.
- g. The parties agree to mutually develop an assessment tool/survey by spring of 2011 to assess the components of UDDI and other curricular related professional development. This assessment should be administered at the end of this school year and each school year thereafter.
- h. The parties agree to make every effort to resolve any disputes that arise at the organizational level where they arise prior to forwarding the matter to the next higher level.
