Summer Reminder: Register to Vote and Request Your Absentee Ballot

As the school year comes to a close and summer begins, FEA encourages members to take a few minutes to ensure their important personal records and documents are up to date. Summer is an excellent time to check items that are often overlooked during the busy school year, including driver's licenses, passports, voter registration, and absentee ballot requests.

For members living and working overseas or away from their voting residence, the Federal Voting Assistance Program (FVAP) provides resources to help U.S. citizens register to vote and request absentee ballots. Using FVAP can help ensure you receive the voting materials you need in time for upcoming elections.

Even if you have voted absentee in the past, it is a good idea to verify your voter registration status and confirm that your absentee ballot request is current. Requirements and deadlines vary by state, so checking early can help prevent last-minute issues.
