Get TSA PreCheck® Ready Before Holiday Travel

The holiday season may feel far away, but now is a good time to make sure you're set up for TSA PreCheck® before Thanksgiving and winter break travel.

DoD federal civilian employees are eligible to opt in to TSA PreCheck® and only need to complete the opt-in process once.

Take care of it now:

- Visit the [DoD ID Card Office Online](#).
- Log in and select "My Profile."
- Select the "CIV" menu tab.
- Follow the instructions to opt in to TSA PreCheck®.
- Once you've opted in, you do not need to repeat the process.

Members of the U.S. Armed Forces do not need to opt in.
